Guidance for competitors:

1. You have two-and-a-half hours to complete your set of nails.
2. Choose a suitable, reliable model.
3. Make sure the finished shape and length of the nails complement the model's hands and nail bed. 4. The smile line should be perfect and exactly the same on each finger with a natural curve to it.
5. The product application should be thick and smooth. The product should be clear with no bubbles or marks in it and there should be no visible filing marks. You should be aiming for the appearance of glass.
6. The varnished hand should be perfectly varnished. The polished should be smooth and free from the cuticle and side walls.
7. Models cannot go to the bathroom during the competition and until after the judging is done. This should be done before and after the competition.
8. Models need to stay for the awards presentation, in case you win, judges and competitors will want to see the nails and photographs will be taken.
